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California Proposition 65 Compliance Statement

GENERAL

California Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. The list of chemicals, maintained by California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), currently contains over 1,100 substances.

A Proposition 65 warning must be provided unless exposure to listed chemicals falls below established Safe Harbor Levels, including:

- **NSRL** – No Significant Risk Level (for carcinogens)
- **MADL** – Maximum Allowable Dose Level (for reproductive toxins)

RISK ANALYSIS

Tecnotion BV has conducted a risk analysis of its products to determine whether any chemicals listed under Proposition 65 are present at levels that could result in significant exposure during normal or foreseeable use, including occupational or consumer contact. This evaluation considered:

- Chemical content based on supplier declarations and material safety data sheets (MSDS)
- Exposure routes (dermal, inhalation, ingestion)
- Usage context and product integration (e.g., built-in vs exposed components)
- Regulatory thresholds (NSRLs, MADLs)
- Additional authoritative scientific sources and OEHHA data

RESULTS

Based on currently available information from our supply chain and risk assessments, Tecnotion BV has not identified any products that require a Proposition 65 warning under current regulations. Any potential exposures are either:

- Below the applicable Safe Harbor Levels, or
- Negligible due to product design or enclosed use (e.g., non-accessible parts)

Where substances are present, exposure is not expected to exceed the thresholds requiring a warning.

Note: Should future findings or regulatory changes indicate the need for a Proposition 65 warning, Tecnotion BV will update product labeling and documentation accordingly.

ONGOING COMPLIANCE

Tecnotion BV is committed to:

- Monitoring regulatory changes to the Proposition 65 chemical list,
- Reevaluating compliance as new materials or processes are introduced,
- Providing clear warnings at the point of sale (including online) if required.
